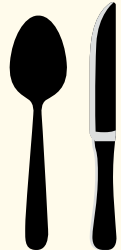

- not what one likes or is interested in.



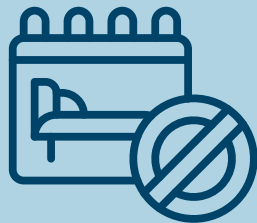

part of something.



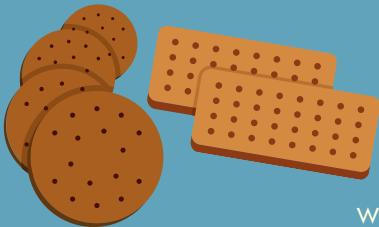
# HAVE A BONE TO PICK WITH SOMEONE
